Behavior coaching will be constructive in nature and include techniques such as:

- Using limits that are fair, consistently applied, appropriate and understandable to your teen's level.
- Providing your teen with reasons for limits.
- Giving positive directions and redirecting your teen to acceptable behavior.
- Helping your teen to constructively express his/her feelings and frustrations to resolve conflict.

The program staff will not use any type of physical or verbal abuse as a disciplinary measure.
